SHOW RULES

The Show Rules will be as per the BAS Show Rules in place on the day of the show, with the following exceptions:

1. All entries must be sired by one of the nominated males, with a maximum of three entries per class per exhibitor. In the event of classes being oversubscribed, the British Alpaca Futurity reserves the right to make withdrawals down to a maximum of two entries per class per exhibitor. Such decisions will be advised and entry fees refunded.
2. Huacaya and Suri Halter Classes are offered and judged based on colour with Colour Champion and Reserve awards only.
3. Huacaya and Suri Halter Classes, in Junior, Intermediate and Adult age ranges
4. Classes up to 10 entries rosettes awarded to 3 places. Classes of 10 entries and over rosettes awarded to 5 places. Sashes awarded for Colour Champion & Reserve, Junior Herd Sire Champion and Futurity Champion Male
5. All Classes to be judged jointly by both Judges
6. There will be no Supreme Champion award. The Junior Herd Sire Champion and Futurity Champion award will be made at the end of judging on Sunday 17th February.
7. The Sire of each placed entry and prize winner will receive prize money equivalent to 10% of its progeny winnings
8. Handlers dress code to be black trousers with white shirt. No white overcoats will be allowed in the judging ring.

Prize Money

- 1st in Class £100; 2nd in class £50; 3rd in class £25; 4th in class £15; 5th in class £5
- Colour Champion £150; Reserve Colour Champion £100
- Futurity Show Champion Guaranteed Minimum £500
(The Show Champion is the Nominated Sire whose progeny win the most prize money. The Futurity organisers will guarantee this to be no less than £500)
- Junior Herd Sire Champion Guaranteed Minimum of £100
- Special Exhibitors Prize £250
(This prize is to be awarded to the most successful exhibitor at the show who owns no more than 30 breeding females born prior to 16th February 2006)
